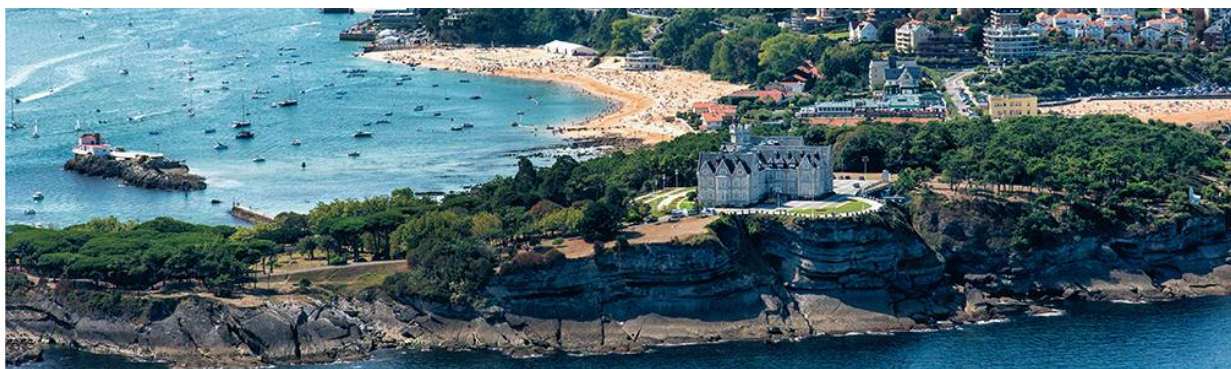


Museo Reina Sofía – Archivo Lafuente (*Art, History & Contemporary Culture*)
